1. Introduction

The Dag Hammarskjöld Foundation, hereinafter the Foundation, is committed to protecting your privacy.

This Cookie Notice explains what cookies are, how the Foundation uses cookies when you visit the Foundation's website, third-party use of cookies and how to restrict or delete cookies. If you have any questions about this Cookie Notice, you may contact the Foundation.

2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small data file that websites place on the computers and mobile devices of people who visit those websites. Cookies allow a site to recognise you as a user when you return using the same device and web browser, either for the duration of your visit (using a 'session cookie') or for repeat visits (a 'persistent cookie').

3. How the Foundation uses cookies

When you use and access the Foundation's website, the Foundation may place a number of cookies in your web browser.

The Foundation uses cookies for the following purposes:

- To allow certain technical functions of the website and to tailor user-specific experiences,
- To analyse usage of the website (for example recognising and counting the number of times you have visited the website) through [Google Analytics](#).

4. Third-party cookies

The Foundation may use certain third-party applications and services to enhance the experience of website visitors. These include social media platforms such as Facebook and Twitter (through the use of sharing buttons), or embedded content from Vimeo. As a result, cookies may be set by these third parties, and used by them to track your online activity. The Foundation is not responsible for and do not control the dissemination of such third-party cookies. Your further use will therefore be subject to such third-party cookie policies.
